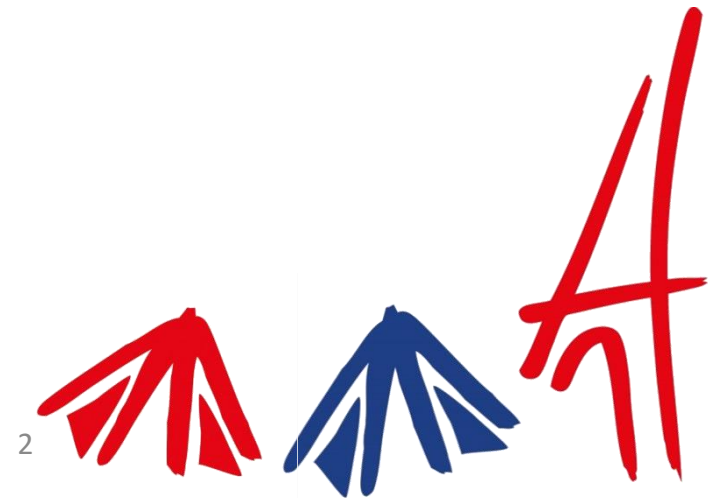

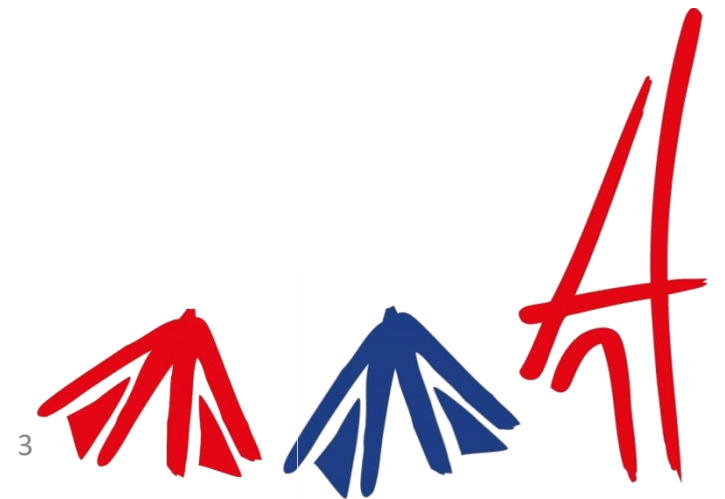
WHAT IS MY ROLE AT ROVERWAY?

- Don't be afraid to admit you are tired/ ill and take some “you time”.



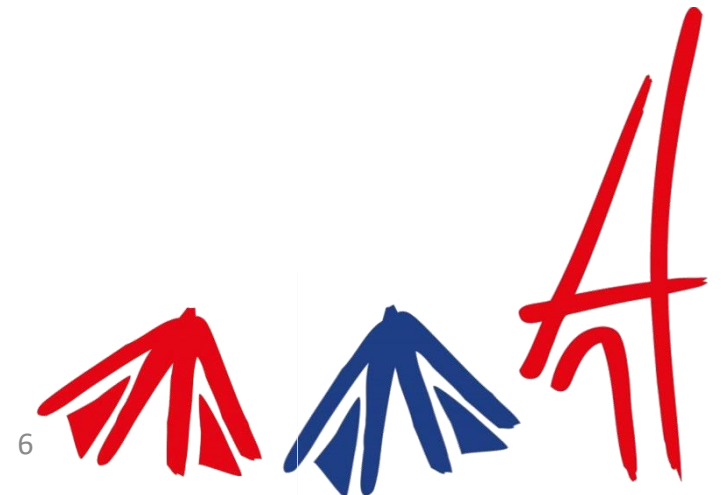
WHAT ARE THE STRENGTHS AND WEAKNESSES OF YOUR PATROL?

WHO IS RESPONSIBLE?

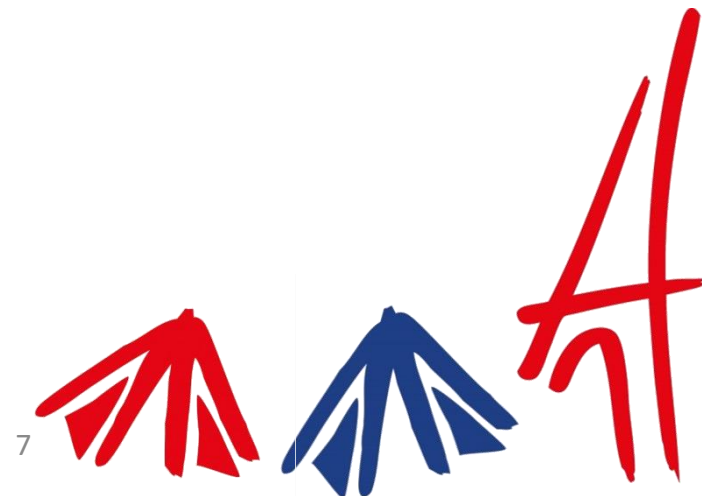
As Patrol Leader you are responsible for safeguarding the young people in your patrol. This includes ensuring they stay happy, healthy and safe. **Please don't worry about this!**

The UK Contingent (Girlguiding and The Scout Association) hold ultimate responsibility for all participants and IST. We will support you in keeping your Patrol safe and to answer any queries or worries that you have.

WHAT IS SAFEGUARDING? DO I HAVE ANY SAFEGUARDING RESPONSIBILITIES.

Safeguarding is protecting young people and vulnerable adults from any sort of harm (physical, mental or emotional).

As over 18's in Girlguiding and Scouting you have a duty to safeguard all young members. This means you should:

- Maintain appropriate relationships with under 18s
- Observe for any signs of abuse, bullying, misconduct or malpractice that may lead to a young person being harmed.
- Pass any concerns to the CMT as soon as possible.

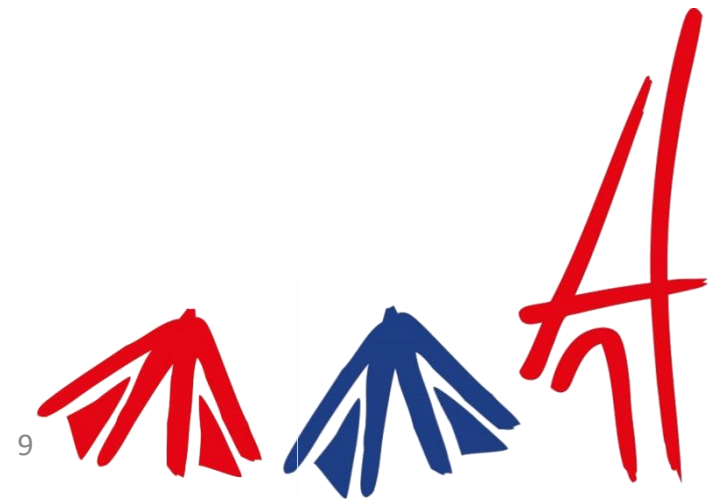


WHAT IF THINGS DON'T GO TO PLAN?

WHAT IF THINGS DON'T GO TO PLAN?

DON'T PANIC!

The UK CMT and French organising team will work together to help you.

You are not required to make any major decisions or contact family in the UK.

The UK CMT will provide phone support, and if necessary will be able to come to your Road to assist in resolving the situation.



WHEN SHOULD I CONTACT CMT?

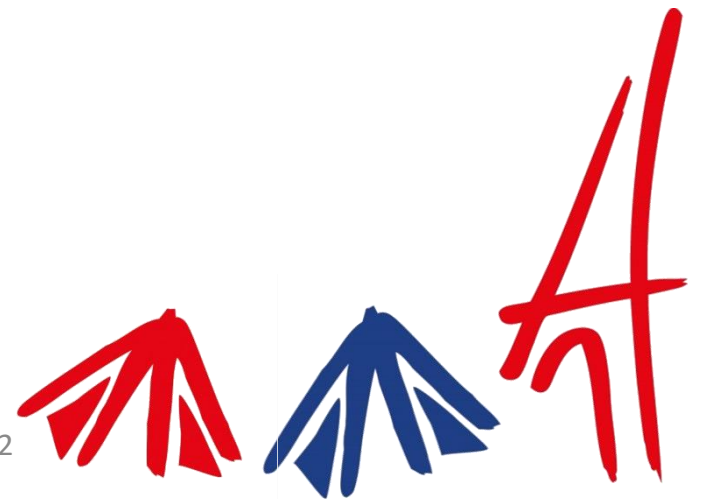
- If you feel uncomfortable or uneasy about a situation
- If you need support in dealing with an issue
- If your gut feeling is to talk to the CMT then talk to us – don't put it off for fear of bothering us... you won't be!
- We can't deal with an issues if you don't tell us.

Please contact the CMT before hitting Twitter or contacting home! It is easier for us to deal with an issues (major or minor) without having to speak to family members who have only heard half of the story! If people at home need to know the UK Contingent will contact them!

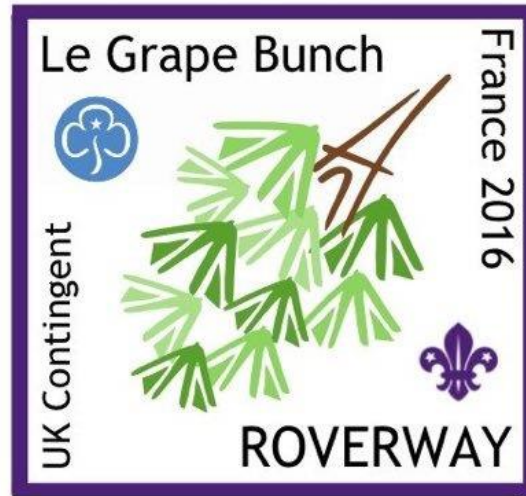
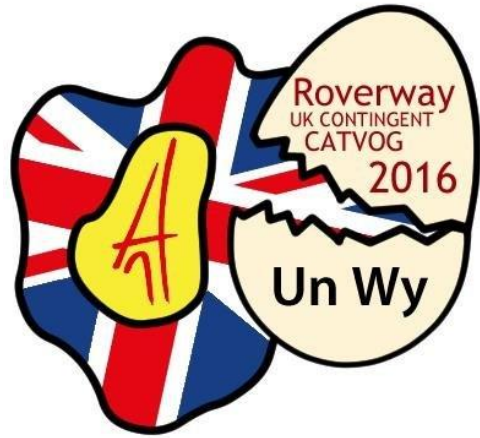
