# Participant – Basic Info

- Patrols of 10 people, max 2 from each country (*we may have a few more!*)
- Information about buddies
- Tribes are made up of four patrols
- Tribes can be single sex but the default is mixed – You can request to be in a single sex patrol/tribe if wanted.
- Tribes live and work together throughout expeditions and Alþingi
- Patrols and tribes choose their leaders
- 2 Advisors work with each tribe but don't lead them

# Participant – Expedition Programme

- 11 Expedition Centres around Iceland.
- Different facilities at each centre.
- The program in each centre is different, tied to local possibilities.
- There are 3 common program themes for all the Expedition centres:
  - Physical activities and adventure (A)
  - Culture and community involvement (C)
  - Nature and environment (N)
- Each Centre is graded 1-3 depending on the length of activities and/or strenuousness.

*Remember that hill walking in Iceland is a lot harder than UK*

# Participant – Expedition Programme

## Culture and Community Involvement (C1, C2, C3)

Focus on community learning and service, history and entertainment

- **C1** A half to full day program combination
- **C2** One to two days program combination
- **C3** Two to three days program combination

## Nature and Environment (N1, N2, N3)

Focus on environmental protection, land compensation, learning and experience.

- **N1** A half to full day program combination
- **N2** One to two days program combination
- **N3** Two to three days program combination

## Physical Activities and Adventure (A1, A2, A3)

Focus on the outdoors

- **A1** A half to two days of outdoor activities following walking paths through hills and flatland.
- **A2** One to three days in a program combination of outdoor activities that are both challenging and strenuous. But if the weather is rainy and windy the program can get quite demanding and difficult.
- **A3** Two to three days in program combination of strenuous physical activities that challenge strength, endurance, mountaineering skills and equipment in the harsh Icelandic nature.

# Participant - Programme

- Participants state a program interest when registering
- Patrols and tribes will consist of people with similar program interests
- Your Buddy must be a similar fitness level to you
- Tribes will get a full list of program activities to choose from
- Program activities have a different grade
- Each activity is either a half day or full day
- Tribes can only choose one program activity with a high grade
- All tribes will have at least a half day community service
