For those who wanted to do sightseeing as part of your IST Post Event, we are currently creating a scavenger hunt around the city which will offer you the chance to see the city with your group and to explore some of the sights in a fun and cost-effective way.

## Communication

Following confirmation of the groups for the Challenge, we will send you an invite to join a Facebook group containing all those IST members who are part of the same Challenge.

The Facebook groups will allow you to share ideas, bring them to life, and decide who will do what to make it happen. We hope this will prevent duplicate requests to the same attractions. A member of the UK Contingent IST Crew will be a member of each Facebook group.

You can decide in your Facebook groups: Who is going to write to the White House to ask for the 105 you to have a tour? How are you going to organise the catering for afternoon tea on the White House lawn? Are you inviting anyone special to join you there? Remember, time may allow you to get more in than you realise. There are no limits to what you could achieve whilst you are out there - aim high!

If you're still developing your ideas, don't worry - there's still time, and we're looking at further ways to help you meet like-minded individuals between now and the Jamboree who will join you in your Washington D.C. Challenge.

### Tell me more

The Sunday afternoon and evening will conclude with a celebration event, where you can relax, unwind and share stories of your Washington D.C. experience. We want you to capture your adventures in pictures and video and share them at this event. We will tell you more about our plans for Sunday afternoon and evening in future editions of ISTea Times.

### Sightseeing Bus Tour

We will be providing an optional sightseeing bus trip on the Saturday afternoon, which may suit those who simply wish to glimpse the sights. The tour will start and finish at your accommodation. You may wish to take the tour as part of your orientation and then set off on your Challenge.
